1. Consider the following fragment of Python code:

```
x = 'Monkey'  
y = x  
z = y[:]  
x = 'D'+x[1:]  
list1 = [1,3,5,7]  
list2 = list1  
list3 = list1[:]  
list1[3] = 9
```

What are the values of the following expressions at this point?

- (a) x[5] 'y'
- (b) z[0:17] 'Monkey'
- (c) x[17] IndexError: string index out of range
- (d) list3[3] 7
- (e) list1[-3:] [3,5,9]
- (f) list2[:-2] [1,3]

2. What is the output of the following Python program?

```
def f(l):  
    l.extend(l[1:])  
    return l  
  
def g(l):  
    return(l + l[1:])  
  
list1 = [7,3,9]  
list2 = f(list1)  
list3 = [19,4]  
list4 = g(list3)  
print(list1,list2,list3,list4)
```
