1. Consider the following fragment of Python code:

```
x = 'Monkey'
y = x
z = y[:]
x = 'D'+x[1:]
```

What are the values of the following expressions at this point?

- (a) `x[5]` 'y'
- (b) `y[0]` 'M'
- (c) `z[0:17]` 'Monkey'
- (d) `x[17]` `IndexError: string index out of range`
- (e) `y*2` 'MonkeyMonkey'

2. Consider the following fragment of Python code:

```
list1 = [1,3,5,7]
list2 = list1
list3 = list1[:]
list1[3] = 9
```

What are the values of the following expressions at this point?

- (a) `list2[3]` 9
- (b) `list3[3]` 7
- (c) `list1[-3:]` [3,5,9]
- (d) `list2[:-2]` [1,3]
- (e) `list3[:]` [1,3,5,7]
